Dear Parents:

Please fill out the form below after reviewing the information on sleds and skis at KMS. Children enrolled in the Elementary and Extended Day programs may bring sleds to school. Those in Elementary may also bring cross-country skis. All equipment brought to school should be labeled with the owner's name. Please be sure your child knows the correct way to put on and fasten the equipment.

Sleds and skis may be left at the school; however, they will not be locked up. They may be left outside the school building, at your own risk. The children will be asked to leave them just around the corner to the left of the building (outside Rebecca's office), rather than in the flowerbeds in front of the school.

Children will not be permitted to sled down the hill behind the school until this form has been returned to office. Please let your child know how you are responding to the questions so he/she will know what to expect. Sharing of equipment will be limited to sleds only.

A teacher supervises sledding, and sleds go down the hill one-at-a-time. Sledding will only be permitted if the teachers feel conditions are appropriate. Elementary children may ski near the building on their own and longer excursions are led by a teacher.
